The proposed funding for this indicator was the US Department of Education 'Application for Grants under Statewide Longitudinal Data System Recovery Act Grants', which was not funded for this round. Due to this, and the 27% vacancy rate in the New Mexico Public Education Department, we are behind schedule on this indicator. We have identified alternative funding (including State and College Access Challenge Grant funds) from which we will be able to address the work for this indicator, and expect that we will be in a position to identify the data by 12/31/10. We will still be on track to post the results by 7/31/11.
