

ALTERNATIVE PORTFOLIO - ELEMENTARY, K-8

- ✓ Bachelor's Degree (from a regionally accredited college or university) including 30 semester hours in a combination of language arts, mathematics, science, history, fine & performing arts and modern, classical & native language courses

OR

- ✓ Master's Degree (from a regionally accredited college or university) including 12 graduate hours in a combination of language arts, mathematics, science, history, fine & performing arts and modern, classical & native language courses

OR

- ✓ Doctor's Degree (from a regionally accredited college or university) in elementary education

AND

- ✓ Letter of interest to undergo the portfolio process

AND

- ✓ Proof of registration to take 6 semester hours of credit in the teaching of reading (must be completed prior to completing portfolio)

AND

- ✓ Proof of registration to take the NM Assessment of Basic Skills, Teacher Competency, Elementary and Content Knowledge in Elementary Education (must be passed prior to completing portfolio)

AND

- ✓ Teach for 1 full school year as the teacher of record while holding an internship license

AND

- ✓ Successfully complete an internet web-based online portfolio that includes evidence of teaching competence that is collected from actual teaching experience

INTERNSHIP LICENSE

A 3-year non-renewal internship license will be granted to allow for completion of reading course work, testing, completing 1 year of teaching experience and submission of the portfolio.
