

SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST, PRE K-12

✓ Bachelor's degree (earned from a regionally accredited college or university)

AND

✓ Master's degree

OR

✓ Educational Specialist Degree

AND

✓ Minimum of 60 graduate hours in a School Psychology program including a practicum in a school setting

OR

✓ Doctoral Degree in Psychology (earned from a regionally accredited college/university) that includes 12 semester hours of child-focused course work in development, assessment and intervention **AND** 600 hours of supervised experience in a school related setting

OR

✓ Possess a psychologist or psychologist associate license issued by the NM Board of Psychologist Examiners that includes 12 semester hours of child-focused course work in development, assessment, and intervention and 600 hours of supervised experience in a school-related setting

AND

✓ Passage of the National Teachers Examination (NTE) Specialty Area in *School Psychology*

OR

✓ Possess a certificate issued by the National Association of School Psychologists
