

ALTERNATIVE SECONDARY, 7-12

- ✓ Bachelor's Degree (from a regionally accredited college or university) including 30 semester hours in a teaching field

OR

- ✓ Master's Degree (from a regionally accredited college or university) including 12 graduate hours in a teaching field

OR

- ✓ Doctor's Degree (from a regionally accredited college or university) in the teaching field

AND

- ✓ Complete 12-21 semester hours in a PED approved alternative program including 3 semester hours of credit in the teaching of reading and a student teaching or field-based component

AND

- ✓ Passage of the New Mexico Teacher Assessments (NMTA)
 - Basic Skills
 - Teacher Competency (Secondary)
 - Content Knowledge Assessment in the teaching field

INTERNSHIP LICENSE

A 3-year non-renewal internship license will be granted to allow for completion of the program and testing.
